



The project REACT is an Erasmus +. KA2 strategic partnership project for adult education that runs for two years, from the beginning of September 2017 to the end of August 2019. The project consortium consists of 5 partners from 4 European Union countries: France, Netherlands, Italy and Finland.

The aim of project REACT - Reinforcing Entrepreneurship in Adults through Communication Technologies - is to enhance entrepreneurship skills amongst disadvantaged adult while developing innovative strategies and methods to be used by teachers/trainers/educators who work on social inclusion and ensure access to training and qualifications for all.

The project addresses to the following five objectives:

- ✓ Improving the adults' awareness on lifelong learning paths;
- Promoting a better understanding of the entrepreneurship competence among adults;
- Carrying out a sample survey of the best projects and tools about peer learning and -peer tutoring methods that already exist;
- Defining and testing innovative tools and practical methods that support adults to improve their entrepreneurial skills;
- ✓ Promoting an innovative tool for the certification of the entrepreneurship competence.

Therefore, for two years, REACT project partners will work on the following activities:

- ✓ Analysis of the best projects and tools about entrepreneurship in order to define a new methodology to develop entrepreneurship competence among adults through the use of gamification and peer learning educational methods;
- ✓ Innovation protocol to propose innovative solutions and tools that contribute to increase the social re-activation of adults within the society;
- Recommendation document that is to say a common framework in order to qualify a project capable of defining common criteria to assess and certify competences related to entrepreneurship skills;
- ✓ E-learning platform which includes key information resources.
